

Pansy 'Cascadia XL'

Pansy 'Cascadia' is a stunning trailing variety, ideal for your hanging baskets, flowering in a wide range of colours. A lovely combination of colours for a beautiful display. These will flower throughout summer and up until late November!

Grown in 3 1/2" pots

Fuchsias - Trailing

With blooms up to 4in across, these trailers guarantee a stunningly colourful display all summer. Plants are individually named but we supply as 'Mixed' as we only grow a few of each. With these plants you can fill your baskets, window boxes and containers with these delightful colourful Fuchsias.

Geranium 'Balcony'

This Trailing Geranium has delicate pink and red flowers that will cascade beautifully from your hanging baskets and containers. They are an early flowering variety and are great in dry conditions, making them perfect for hanging baskets. A fantastic plant when you want vibrant colour in your garden.

Sweet Peas

With larger blooms and more flowers to a stem as compared to the ordinary Spencer type, this is a fine and inexpensive range of Sweet Peas with long, sturdy stems and the lovely scent. And remember, the more you pick, the more they produce and a vase of Sweet Peas is a welcoming sight - and perfume - in any room. Very easy to grow...

Petunia 'Surfinia''

World renowned for their flower power, weather resistance, colour range and versatility. With their long trailing stems, reaching up to 35", Surfinia petunias are ideal for creating a cascade of colour from hanging baskets, flower pouches® and containers. For a less formal display, let these vigorous trailing petunias tumble over walls in a wave of trumpet shaped blooms. Trails to: 35". 5 colours grown (*subject to availability*). *Grown in 4" pots*

Petunia 'Bolero'

Petunia Bolero is an early flowering variety, bearing double and semi-double blooms in glorious shades of pink and purple. With its good weather tolerance and compact habit, it's a great addition to your garden this Summer. Height & Spread: 10" -16"

Grown in 3 1/2" pots

Phlox 'Pop Stars Britannia'

A stunning variety of Phlox which will produce a wealth of star-shaped bloom in patriotic shades of red, blue and white. They are ideal for adding glorious colour to your borders and containers from June until the frosts arrive. Height! 12 ins.

Begonia 'Big'

Begonia 'Big' is the bigger, better begonia! It thrives in a wide range of climates and soils, performing in full sun, full shade, and all points in between. The blooms are huge, up to 3 times larger than traditional wax begonias. Spent flowers will fall off the plant, so no deadheading is needed.

'Big' is perfect for patio containers, baskets and garden beds - just remember to space the bedded plants further apart than usual, about 15 inches. Plants will reach their maximum size in warmer climates with high moisture levels. Grown in 3 1/2" pots



Begonia 'Illumination Mixed''

These sharp, colourful blooms are in vogue at present; they add a real 'zing' and freshness to summer pots and baskets, flowering in profusion on attractive trailing plants. This breathtakingly beautiful trailing variety is not only pest and disease resistant but is an ultradependable performer, right at home even in cool, wet conditions and will grow as happily in sun as semi-shade and keep going all summer long and well into autumn, presenting you with flowing cascades of double blooms. *Grown in 3 1/2" pots*

Begonia 'Illumination Apricot'

As above but with delightful apricot-coloured blooms with a true cascading habit that spill over in a spectacular display of colour.

Begonia Non-Stop Mocca Mixed'

Begonia Non-Stop Mocca Mixed - a chocolate coloured leaf & mixed coloured flower variety upright in nature growing to approx. 12" tall. Flowers throughout the whole summer into Autumn & is very weather tolerant!

Begonia 'Non-Stop Fire'

The glowing ember shades of Begonia 'Non-Stop Fire' create a dazzling display. This radiant new variety is the latest addition to the popular 'Non-Stop' series, delivering an impeccable display of double orange blooms with darker outer edges. With weather resistant flowers and a gently cascading habit, these long-lasting tuberous begonias will keep basket and containers bursting with colour, right through to autumn - long after most summer flowering plants have faded. Begonia 'Lotto'

An exceptionally large flowered variety compared to normal Begonia semperflorens cultivars. Begonia 'Lotto' Mixed plants produce neat blooms with yellow centres in a sumptuous mix of colours. Perfect for creating a show-stopping display in containers, beds, baskets, and Flower Pouches[™]! Height and spread: 12".

Begonia 'Funky Pink'

Begonia 'Funky Pink' rivals the performance of the best-selling 'Apricot Shades' Begonia! Ideal in baskets and containers, thanks to its trailing habit, 'Funky Pink' produces masses of unusually- shaped, large, double flowers in a lovely salmon pink with flecks of gold and striking orange centres. Easy to grow, compact, well-branched begonia plants provide an outstanding display, flowering over many weeks from June to September. Happy in full sun or semi-shade, enjoy these stunning weather-tolerant

begonia blooms in mixed containers or planted on their own in a hanging basket - they'll look amazing wherever you grow them! Height and spread: 20". *Grown in 3 1/2" pots*

Gerbera 'Revolution Mixed'

An early bloomer producing masses of large daisylike blooms in a ravishing mix of colours. Compact in habit and uniform flowering, they are perfect for livening up borders, cutting gardens and pots.

Height & Spread : 12"

Freesias

One of the most attractive and sweetly fragrant summer flowering bulbs, supplied in a stunning array of bright colours, these will be perfect for growing in pots on your patio or planting in beds or borders. They will over-winter in mild winters, and produce bigger and better displays in future years. These beauties no longer need to be simply a treat, so grow your own, and you can enjoy bountiful crops to pick again and again. They thrive in pots in warm spots, or in well-drained soil, they will flower

throughout summer. Height 12 - 15". Grown in 5" pots



Oriental Lilies

Fill your summer garden with an explosion of tropical colour! Oriental Lilies are prized for their large, trumpet shaped flowers and powerful fragrance. The tall, sturdy stems are cloaked in dark green foliage creating the perfect contrast to their vibrant coloured blooms. Plant the bulbs in groups for the most dramatic effect - they will virtually look after themselves. These reliable bulbs will return year after year, creating a show stopping performance in your beds, borders and containers in mid-summer. Height: 36" *Grown in 5" - 6" pots*

Asiatic-Longiflorum Lilies

Recent Lily breeding has created some huge and beautifully fragrant Oriental type Lilies, in their pinks and whites, their brighter, bolder and brighter Asiatic cousins seem to have been left out. Not any more following their breeding with the ever-popualr Longilforum scented lilies, to create Longiflorum Asiatic (LA) hybrids. With their beautiful sunshine rays of colours in a range of bold 'fruit-salad shades' in vellow, berry pink, orange and red, these vibrant and hot tropical colours really light up your hot summer garden, and they even inherit some of the fragrance of their parents too. Short and strong enough to grow in pots, yet tall enough to cut armfuls of flowers each summer, they are versatile, and very hardy and easy. Plant en masse in large pots or in groups for maximum impact, or maybe just dot them round your garden to brighten up odd spots. 24-30" tall.

Grown in 5" - 6" pots Festuca glauca (perennial)

The truest blue of the dwarf grasses and totally drought-proof once established, this is a gem for a rock garden. The stiff thread-like blue foliage and steel blue flower-heads form dense rather upright tussocks, which look good grown for foliage interest amongst a wide variety of rock plants. They are also good subjects for containers and look brilliant in terracotta pots. Plants develop their most intense coloration when kept dry in summer. Hardy Perennial/Grown in 5" pots

Achillea 'Cerise Queen'

The showy flower heads are produced on plentiful stems throughout the season and are incredibly eye-catching - pollinating insects love them! Resilient and low-maintenance, Achillea is ideal for cottage garden borders and wildlife gardens it will even tolerate coastal gardens. The long stems and unusual flower heads make lovely informal cut flowers for floral displays. Height: 3ft. Spread: 20".

Dianthus 'Rockin' Red'

This new interspecific hybrid brings the strongest shade of red we've seen in a Sweet William. The pillar-box red flowers make an exciting display in summer beds and borders, gently perfuming the air with their sweet, spicy fragrance. Dianthus barbatus 'Rockin' Red' is a reliable hardy perennial that puts on a durable performance each year. Height: 20" & Spread: 12".

Lewisia cotyledon 'Elise Mixed'

Masses of starry flowers in a range of fruity colours, including stripes and picotees adorn slender stems above neat rosettes of fleshy leaves. Traditionally grown as perennials in alpine houses, new breeding has brought us Lewisia 'Elise Mixed' which is easier to grow giving a very colourful summer flowering plant.! Winner of a Fleuroselect Gold Medal, these exceptional plants repeat flower throughout summer, lighting up beds, borders, containers and rock gardens. Tolerating heat and drought well, Lewisia is also perfectly happy with cooler temperatures. Height: 10" & Spread: 12". Hardy Perennial/Grown in 4" pots

Lychnis viscaria (perennial)

Spires of bright magenta pink flowers in spring and early summer on this seemingly overlooked herbaceous perennial. Very hardy and easy to grow in ordinary soil in sun or light shade it gives a good display and has attractive seed-heads too. With its candelabra style of flower spikes it resembles one of the spring flowering candelabra Primulas. 24" tall Hardy Perennial/Grown in 5" pots

Hollyhock 'Chaters Double'

Tall spires of tightly ruffled, frilled blooms open from bottom to top of the magnificent flower spikes, giving height and impact as well as a nostalgic touch. Long-lasting spires of this specially selected hollyhock mixture features a range of vivid colours that will bring masses of flowers throughout summer.

Extremely easy to grow and super-tough, Hollyhocks are very hardy and perennial, providing you with month of glorious colour each year and get bigger and better in subsequent seasons. Height 5 - 6ft

Hardy Fuchsias

Hardy fuchsias will rescue a fading summer garden with a flurry of colourful blooms that last well into autumn. Great among shrubs in borders or as a colourful addition to containers; they'll become more impressive as the years go by. They'll become a staple feature in your borders thanks to their reliable flowering and good, bushy habit. We have a few different types available but limited in numbers of each. Height up to 3ft, spread 2ft.
