Domestic overnight stays are allowed, in groups of up to six people or 2 households.	Schools, colleges and universities fully open. Regular testing provided.	You should continue to work from home if you can.

Open. Groups of up to six people or two households allowed indoors. Groups of up to 30 allowed outdoors.	All holiday accommodation open, including hotels, hostels and B&Bs. People who live in a care home can have 'low risk' visits out of the home without the need to isolate when they get back. Residents can also name up to five visitors.
