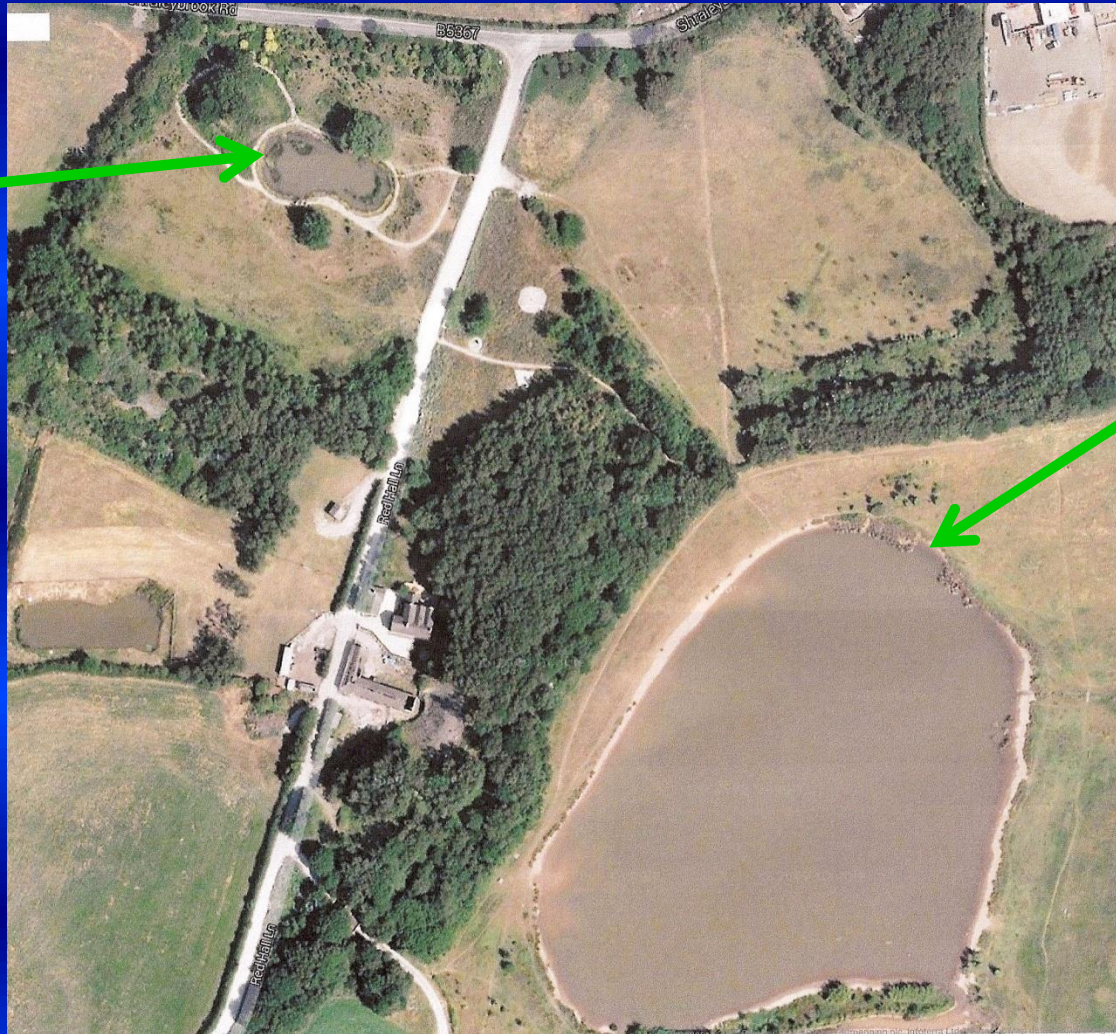
- **October 2011 – Initial contact with Newcastle Borough Council enquiring about fishing rights.**
- **July 2013 - Parish Council meeting held at Wood Lane where we expressed our interest in forming an angling club.**
- **August 2013 - Meeting at civic offices to discuss legal obligations etc. Verbal agreement given to proceed with the setting up of the club.**
- **Start up budget costs -£2000.00 approx.- set at first committee meeting held in The Royal Oak, Miles Green, on 28th August 2013.**
- **APAC Club Constitution , Equality, Health & Safety , Child Protection and Risk Assessment documents drawn up and agreed with Newcastle Borough Council between August and November 2013.**
- **Club officially launched on 1st April 2014.**
- **Fishing Management Agreement signed 17th January 2015**

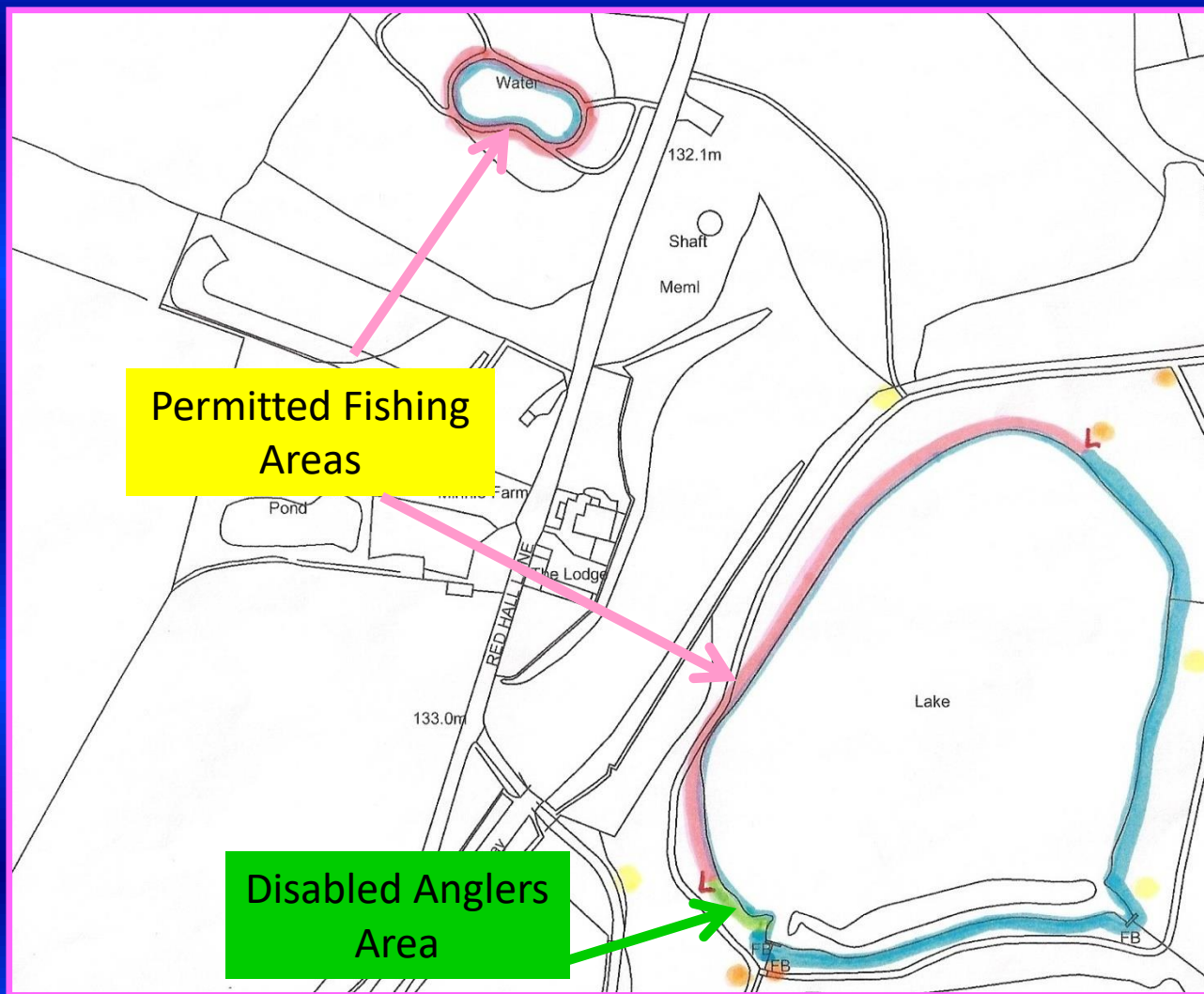

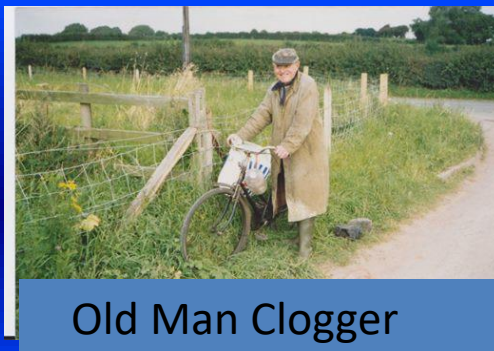
AUDLEY PARISH ANGLING CLUB
